Wolf of the Willows 'XPA' Pale Ale

(4.7%, VIC, 330ml) Extra pale in colour with Extra hop aroma and flavour. Passionfruit, citrus and tropical fruits are supported by a subtle, biscuity malt and a soft, round bitterness. Easy, flavoursome drinking for the hop lover.

Young Henrys 'Natural Lager'

(4.2%, NSW, 375ml) A balanced beer with a hazy golden hue with Australian noble hop character.

Newstead 'Liquidambar' Amber Ale

(4.8%, BRISBANE, 330ml) All about sweet, sweet nectar. Noble-style hops add spice; roasted specialty malts drive flavour depth

La Sirene 'Urban Pale Ale'

(4.9%, VIC, 375ml) Created to fit snugly between the Pale ale and the IPA. Hop culture is an approachable IPA using Equinox & Citra hops creating a fruit-bomb aroma. A lean palate, medium bitterness, aromas of lemon, citrus and mango

Yulli's Bews 'Slick Rick's Rampaging Red Ale'

(4.8%, SYD, 330ml) All about sweet, sweet nectar. Noble-style hops add spice; roasted specialty malts drive flavour depth

AleSmith 'Lil Devil' Belgian Pale Ale

(5.25%, US, 650ml) AleSmith X is our refreshing Extra Pale Ale. Pale Yellow color, bright white head. Aroma of fresh hops with notes of citrus and pine.

THE HOPPY, BITTER, DANK BANK (IPAs, HOP-DRIVEN BEERS, ETC..)

Wolf of the Willows 'IPA: Homage'

(6.2%, VIC, 330ml) This IPA pays respect to American West Coast IPAs. Resin, pine, and layers of stone fruit. 66 IBUs. **11**

Rocks Brewing 'Conviction Series: IPA'

(7.0%, SYDNEY, 330ml) Never mind a truckload, this brew has several semi-trailers worth of hops involved in its production. Unlike the traditional English version, this IPA ran aground in California – taking on board a slew of Cascade, Chinook and Centennial hops from the Pacific Northwest – meaning this 70IBU IPA is bigger and bolder, and expertly balanced with a solid malt bill **11**

Pirate Life IPA

(6.8%, SA, 355ml) This IPA has a gentle orange hue and a round, full bodied malt character care of Pale Malt, Munich and Crystal. With our Pale Ale and IPA having withdrawn most of our funds from the dank bank we thought it was time to make a beer that brought something a little different to the table. Chock full of Centennial, Riwaka and Simcoe our IPA is bright, fruity and full of liquid fun **11**

Black Hops 'Flash Bang' White IPA

(6.8%, GOLD COAST, 330ml) An American Wheat IPA with big citrus and pine hop aromas. Light bodied with a smooth finish, perfect IPA to get you through the hot weather. **12**

Feral 'War Hog' Double IPA

(7.5%, WA, 375ml) Prepare to be tagged and bagged as this Full Metal Jacket of an IPA rains an apocalyptic hellfire of clustered hops and passionfruit aromas upon the senses. There's nowhere to hide, so gear up, sound off, and blast "Ride of the Valkyries" at full volume, because, soldier, you're at war. We love the taste of IPA in the morning **13**

Merchant Brewing 'Hasslesloth' IPA

(7.2%, NSW, 330ml) Our take on the West Coast IPA: all your senses should be focused towards the truckload of hops we added to this beer (NZ and US varieties). Token hop aromas: citrus, pine, grapefruit. The hops overtake the palate with a lingering bitterness nearly as long as a Baywatch beach montage... **13**

AleSmith 'IPA'

(7.25%, US, 330ml) A San Diego classic, AleSmith IPA showcases the versatility of American hops. Aromas of grapefruit and tangerine lead into an abundance of fresh pine and tropical fruit notes followed by a crisp, resinous bitterness. The complex hop profile is supported by a firm malt presence to create an incredibly flavorful and well-balanced IPA. **14**

Green Flash Brewing 'Soul Style IPA'

(6.5%, CALIFORNIA, USA, 330ml) Confident that the brewing team would develop an outstanding single IPA, the name "Soul Style" refers to the grace of the rarely seen, soul style surfer who leans way back on the board, making each difficult maneuver appear effortless. Soul Style is the Green Flash approach the art of crafting the perfect IPA. Citra, Simcoe and Cascade hops are layered to allow bright tropical citrus to mingle with waves of floral notes that break gently on the palate **16**

BrewCult / Frankies Pizza 'Bloodsucking Geeks' Mid-strength Red IPA

(3.4%, VIC, 500ml) An epic collaboration between BrewCult and Frankie's Pizza By The Slice, Bloodsucking Geeks is an extreme extrapolation beer that strangles the ABV and tortures gratuitous amounts of hops. Be brainwashed by this blood red beer. Brewed in celebration of Sydney Craft beer week. **17**

Belching Beaver 'Here Comes Mango!' IPA

(6.5%, USA, 650ml) A juicy mango infused IPA, the fruit accentuates tropical hops for a flavorful yet balanced clean finish. We're not lying about the 'Here Comes' part: as you drink it the mango starts delicately and then POW! MANGO! **30**

Knee Deep 'Hoptologist Double IPA

(9.0%, USA, 650ml) An American Double India Pale Ale that packs a punch when it comes to hops. The aroma and flavors will give you citrus and pine with a slight malt sweetness that finishes dry. **30**

Evil Twin 'Calypso'

(8.0%, NY, 650ml) Though this is using a lager yeast, it firmly belongs in the IPA section because IPA drinkers will want to drink this! Single Hop Imperial Wheat Lager with Calypso Hops. Lovely mouthfeel, super hoppy and very, very delicious. **42**

Evil Twin 'Molotov Heavy' Imperial IPA

(17.2%, NY, 650ml) Despite the crudeness it is tricky to make an effective Molotov cocktail. Despite the unruly nature of the rebel it is very tricky to resist accepted conventions. Molotov Heavy is a tour de force in rebellious hoppiness, it's a heavy spark for action and by far one of the most anti-authoritative beers ever made by Evil Twin Brewing. **58**

DARKNESS! (PORTERS, STOUTS, DARK ALES ETC)

Wolf of the Willows 'JSP' Porter

9.5

(5.2%, VIC, 330ml) The Johnny Smoked Porter (JSP) uses a touch of rauch malt (smoked malt) from Germany alongside various other dark malts to create layers of sweetness, smoke and more espresso like characters.

Stone and Wood 'Stone Beer'

17

(6.5%, Byron Bay, NSW, 500ml) Made as a homage to the old brewing technique of super-heating rocks and placing them into water to boil the barley mash, this annual release is bursting with lovely caramelly malt character. Full bodied, smooth and dry.

Moon Dog 'Jumping The Shark' - Imperial Stout, 2015 Version

41

(18.4%, VIC, 375ml) Barrel-Aged for four months in rye whisky barrels from Tasmania's Belgrove Distillery, with the result a "stupidly tasty" melange of "rich dark chocolate, molasses, hazelnuts and boozy rumminess."

BrewDog 'Black Eyed King: Vietnamese Coffee Edition' Imperial Stout

(12.7%, SCOTLAND, 330ml) World's strongest canned ale. Because hey, BrewDog aren't known to do things by halves!

Red Duck 'Dr F MONSTER STOUT' - Barrel Aged Imperial Stout

45

(10.1%, VIC, 750ml) One of only 312 bottles made! A big, dark, complex, lush and strong barrel aged dark ale. As well as loads of dark malts, they added muscovado sugar, panela sugar, dark brown sugar, molasses, coffee, chocolate, some lactose and their own 110 pod vanilla tincture. After 6 months in oak, the hops soften & balance all the huge malt, chocolate, coffee and vanilla flavours.

BrewDog 'Paradox Islay' Whisky Cask Aged Imperial Stout

48

(15.0%, SCOTLAND, 330ml) Paradox Islay is the latest of our whisky cask aged imperial stouts to be released from its smoky, shadowy cocoon. We have kept our Paradox locked away for 178 days in Islay whisky barrels before bottling. Roasty malt flavours of coffee and chocolate combine with smoky molasses. Spicy hop bitterness balances the malt, before layers and layers of rich, peaty Islay whisky character build to epic proportions.

BrewDog 'Dog E' Barrel Aged Imperial Stout

48

(16.1%, SCOTLAND, 330ml) Dog E is an extra special brew, marking 9 years of BrewDog. Like dogs A to D before it, Dog E is an imperial stout with speciality ingredients, then barrel-aged. Dog E pours like dark matter into your glass, with a deep tan head. The nose is subtle but powerful, and on the palate, there's a treacle toffee backbone, supporting the spicy hop flavour and naga chilli heat. Dog E is like eating chocolate ice cream and drinking cognac in a leather armchair.

Garage Project 'Cherry Bomb' Cherry & Chocolate Imperial Porter

48

(9.0%, NEW ZEALAND, 650ml) Cherry Bomb is a cherry, chocolate Imperial Porter. Weighing in at a thoroughly warming 9%, it's a rich ebony/mahogany colour, with layers of cacao nib bitter-sweet dark chocolate and a distinct tart cherry tang (and hints of stone age love).

Hargreaves Hill 'RIS' - Russian Imperial Stout - 2014 Release

52

(10.8%, VIC, 750ml) Brewed with a complex grist of 4 dark malts to produce intense flavour, colour and aroma. High levels of hop bitterness ensure balance with the residual malt sweetness.

BrewDog 'Abstrakt AB:17' Imperial Porter

54

(10.9%, SCOTLAND, 375ml) Three Coffee Rye Imperial Porter. Big chocolatey roasty malts, spicy rye, and more coffee than Twin Peaks - we've added espresso in the mash, cafetiere in the boil, and whole bean in the whirlpool and the FV. Courtesy of Has Bean, we've got a rich mix of spicy, bitter and heady coffee flavours mixing with the vanilla pods we threw in for good measure.

AleSmith 'Speedway Stout'

58

(12.0%, US, 750ml) Speedway Stout's ominous, pitch-black appearance has become a hallmark of this modern-day classic. Chocolate and roasted malts dominate the flavor, supported by notes of dark fruit, toffee, and caramel. A healthy dose of locally-roasted coffee from Ryan Bros. Coffee, Inc. added to each batch brings out the beer's dark chocolate flavors and enhances its drinkability. Despite its intensity, Speedway Stout's fine carbonation and creamy mouthfeel make it very smooth and surprisingly easy to drink.

Nail Brewing 'Clout Stout' Russian Imperial Stout 2015 (10.6%) & 2016 (11.0% ABV) versions available!

(WA, 750ml) Only 700 bottles produced annually. A myriad of decadent flavours and aromas: creme caramel, figs, mocha, chocolate, vanilla and sweet liquorice. It becomes increasingly liqueur like as it warms; so velvety, in fact, that it's hard to believe it's a 10.5 percent ABV beer.

PUCKERING, SOUR AND BRIGHT (SOURS & SAISONS)

- Boatrockers 'Miss Pinky' Raspberry Berlinerweisse** **8.5**
(3.4%, Melb, 330ml). 100kg of fresh, locally sourced raspberries were then added to the fermenter to help give this beer its distinctive colour, aroma and flavour.
- Wolf of the Willows 'India Saison'** **9.5**
(5.2%, Melb, 330ml). Abundant layers of new world hops whilst integrating the complexities of Belgian farmhouse yeast.
- Mayday Hills (aka Bridge Rd) 'Yee-Hah!' Oak-aged Brettanomyces Pale Ale** **16**
(6.0%, VIC, 330ml). Mayday Hills is a new series of 100% Brettanomyces beers fermented in a traditional wooden foeder tank. Bridge Rd Brewers want to demonstrate that Brettanomyces beers can be, "clean, fruity and textural, rather than funky, horsey, earthy". Watch for some oak influence from the virgin foeder.
- Dainton 'Blood Orange Berlinerweisse'** **22**
(3.5%, VICTORIA, 500ml) Based on the traditional German Berliner Weisse style with the added hint of Blood Oranges, it is light, cloudy, and "bloody" refreshing! It is effervescent and dry with a quick, slightly tangy finish.
- Batch Brewing 'Plum DMC: The Remix' Plum Sour Ale** **28**
(4.0%, SYDNEY, 640ml) Sour ales domination is high, sours coming, sours going, sours feelin' fly. Ask about the remix and we'll tell you why. Yeah it's like that, and that's the way it is. Gladfield malt to make ends meet. American Ale for that added yeast treat. Gentle bittering hops work hard to compete. It's like that, and that's the way it is. Plums help carve the way. Perfect antidote to a long day. So we all stay young, go out and play. It's like that, and that's the way it is. Lactobacillus is the key to end all your woes. Your ups and your downs, your highs and your lows. Tell me the last time you were offered a plum and said no. It's like THAT, and that's the way it is. HUH!
- Batch Brewing 'Pash the Magic Dragon' Passionfruit/ Dragonfruit Sour Ale** **28**
(5.1%, SYDNEY, 640ml). Pash the Magic Dragon lived by the brewery, and frolicked in a golden grist of flaked wheat and barley. His friend, Jackie Paper, loved that rascal Pash, and brought him malt to help him sour that crisp and tasty mash. Oh! Together they would sour wort with some lactic acid, Jackie kept a lookout to make sure it wasn't flaccid. But one wanted a sweet and yellow from some passionfruit, the other wanted pink and tart from some dragon fruit. Oh! The dragon and his friend, they bickered all night long, til they finally realised that neither one was wrong! They put each fruit into the beer and let it settle out, the friendship saved! The beer was great! Was there any doubt?!
- Almanac Beer Co 'Lavender Honey De Brettaville'** **38**
(6.5%, California, 375ml) Hand-picked lavender & aromatic wildflower honey is layered together with an oak-fermented brettanomyces blonde base beer to create this funky, floral delight. A hint of minerality provides a complex backdrop of floral spring flavors, and a nose of meyer lemons, aromatic botanicals and bosc pear.
- Tilquin 'Oude Gueuze A L'Ancienne'** **38**
(7.6%, BELGIUM, 375ml) A spontaneous fermentation beer, produced from the blending of 1, 2 and 3 year old lambics. It is unfiltered and unpasteurized, and refermented in the bottle for at least 6 months. The lambics used were fermented and oak aged in our installations. These lambics are coming from worts brewed by Boon, Lindemans, Girardin and Cantillon breweries.
- 3 Fonteinen 'Oude Gueuze Golden Blend'** **46**
(6.0%, BELGIUM, 375ml) Made with 4 y/o Lambic accounting for 25%, and the remainder a secret blend of 1, 2 and 3 year old Lambic - known only to the master blender Armand.
- Boatrockers 'L.A.B.' Blended Flanders Style Red Ale** **48**
(6.5%, MELB, 500ml). L.A.B. is a blend of barrel-aged beers that are between 12 and 24 months old. It pours a hazy, ruddy red and displays the broad range of characteristics for which the style, of which Rodenbach is the most famous producer, is known. The acetic acid lends the aroma a balsamic character alongside the creamy toffee sweetness; there are cherries and dark berries, vinous qualities and even a hint of vanilla, all tied up by a cleansing acidic sourness.
- Brouwerij Verhaeghe 'Duchesse De Bourgogne' Sour Red / Brown** **52**
(6.2%, BELGIUM, 750ml) traditional Flemish red ale. This refreshing ale is matured in oak casks; smooth with a rich texture and interplay of passion fruit, and chocolate, and a long, dry and acidic finish. After the first and secondary fermentation, the beer goes for maturation into the oak barrels for 18 months. The final product is a blend of younger 8 months old beer with 18 months old beer. The average age of the Duchesse de Bourgogne before being bottled is 12 months
- Wild Beer / Burning Sky / Good George 'Shnoodlepip' Sour / Wild Ale** **55**
(6.5%, ENGLAND, 750ml) A collaboration of 3 brewers, 3 nationalities and 6 ideas. Somerset Sharpham Park Spelt has been used for a full body. Pink peppercorns give a gentle sweet spiciness. Saison and Brettanomyces yeast strains lead to a dry spicy character that will continue to evolve. Wood-ageing in French red wine barrels for 4 months adds depth and oak. Passion-fruit brings a tart tropical fruit character. The 4 month ageing process has been finished off with amazingly tangy Hibiscus flowers.
- Mikkeller 'Spontandoubleblueberry'** **62**
(7.7%, BELGIUM, 375ml) This is the Super limited 'DOUBLE' series within the regular 'Spontan' series. Barrel Aged in oak, Spontandoubleblueberry comes highly sought after because of its sour intensity and the exploding blueberry landscape.
- Bruery Terreux 'Tart of Darkness' Barrel-aged Sour Stout** **77**
(7.2%, USA, 750ml) Tart of Darkness is a traditional stout that we aged in used oak barrels from The Bruery that had previously housed beers such as Cuivre™ or Black Tuesday®. We then brought them over to Bruery Terreux, added our special blend of souring bacteria and wild yeasts and watched nature take its course. The result is a perfectly tart yet awesomely dark and roasty, sour stout. Not a style you will see very often, and in our opinion, not a style seen often enough. This unique stout has notes of tart plums, roasted coffee, vanilla and oak



BOTTLED BEER

BIG, BOLD & BALLSY... (BIG ALES, BARLEYWINES, BELGIANS)

La Sirène 'Avant Garde Collection'....An evolution in Table Beers.

The intention of this limited release series is to embrace the subtleties (and overtness in some cases) that can emanate with time and patience when various local & wild strains of yeast/bacteria are allowed to blossom, impart and express themselves in the beer without any oak or wood (or overt malt/hop characters) to steal the show.

La Sirène 'Avant Garde Collection: Bière de Provision'

(3.8%, Alphington, VIC, 750ml). Farmhouse Style - Workers Beer - Floral Crisp Refreshing
Our 'Provision beer' that is drunk frequently and for reasons of hydration (by us anyways) is a light 3.8% ABV light bodied beer that embodies the spirit of a true provision beer. The unique wild yeast here imparts tart refreshment with a hint of wild woods.

La Sirène 'Avant Garde Collection: Long Table'

(5.0%, Alphington, VIC, 750ml). Farmhouse Style - Table Beer - Earthy, Fruit Driven
Our interpretation of an easy drinking Farnhouse - style table beer. Creamy rounded mouthfeel that pairs well with crusty bread and a simple elegance that can be drunk all day long.

La Sirène 'Avant Garde Collection: Soixante'

(6.0%, Alphington, VIC, 750ml). Farmhouse Ale - Mixed Fermentation - Earthy, Tart, Piquant
To say overt is an understatement - perhaps the opposite of the provision beer. There are no subtleties with the Soixante, just pronounced wild yeast wet hay & horse stable characters. This beer will polarise yet delight for some. This experiment shows what can happen when time and wild yeast are allowed to hangout with the an abundance of food.

Nøgne Ø 'Sunturmbrew'

(11.0%, NORWAY, 650ml) Brewed just before Christmas, the Sunturmbrew honors the Norwegian legend that says that the sun turns on December 21st, the shortest day of the year. While the rest of the world argues that the sun doesn't turn at all, Nøgne Ø raises a glass to Norwegian stubbornness with this celebratory beer! It's a smoked barleywine, brewed with 30% smoked malt and 20% rye.

Boatrockers 'Sterk & Donker'

(10.5%, VIC, 330ml) Meaning 'Strong & Dark', this Belgian Quadruple certainly delivers on its namesake. Big sweet roasted malts and notes of fig & raisins.

28

Red Duck 'Valhalla'

(16.4%, VIC, 375ml) Red Duck's 100th beer, brewed to commemorate their 10th Anniversary in 2015! This is barrel fermented and barrel aged for over 6 months using just an ale yeast to get it up to 14 percent. Red Duck went ahead and filled two kegs with the beer in that state, which were tapped at the time as "Valhalla Light" at two Ballarat venues, local to Red Duck. The rest (these bottles) were nudged beyond 16 percent with whiskey yeast. Expect really rich, malty flavours, sweet and complex & deliberately still.

Dainton Family Brewery 'Manhattan Ale' Barrel Aged Belgian Rye Ale

(9.7%, Dandenong, VIC, 650ml) From The Crafty Pint: "Belgian Abbey style ale featuring plenty of rye, which was then aged in ex-Stardawd whisky barrels that themselves once housed Pedro Ximenez. The beer spent six months inside oak and has picked up plenty of character from that time. The barrels lend the beer a drying woody quality, while the fruitiness and spiciness of the base beer - plus a touch of whisky juiciness - comes through as it warms..."

Moon Dog 'Jumping the Shark 2014'

(14.1%, VIC, 375ml) Hungarian Oak Barrel-aged Saffron'd Imperial Red Ale. It's as complex, strange, wonderful as all of that sounds.

Boatrockers 'Banshee' Barleywine

(14.2%, VIC, 330ml) An English style barleywine aged for 6 months in New World Distillery whisky barrels (ex-Pedro Ximenez), then aged for a further 8 months to allow the beer to find itself. This beer is a decadent example of the style, with luscious whisky notes complemented perfectly by the huge malt character. Perfect for drinking on a cold winters night, now or in a few years.

7 Cent Brewery '6 Fifths' Barleywine

(14.6%, VIC, 375ml) This epic barleywine has spent no less than 18 months in whiskey barrels allowing it to express a gargantuan barrage of flavours. Expect sweet maltiness, toffee, dried fruit, barrel char, vanilla & loads of oak.

Brisbane Brewing Co 'Gnarley Wine' Barleywine

(11.6%, BRISBANE, 650ml) This very limited release has been aged in two 100 litre ex-Shiraz wine barrels procured from Yalumba Wines. The resulting beer is as described, pretty damn gnarley. In a good way. Like, totally, tubular, gnarley dude.

AleSmith 'Old Numbskull'

(11.0%, US, 750ml) Caramel and toffee notes abound in this deep copper-colored American Barleywine-style ale alongside toasted malt and a hint of ripe dark fruits. Old Numbskull showcases malt sweetness, intense American hops, and an aggressive bitterness. Extremely well-balanced, the full-bodied mouthfeel and assertive hop profile leads into a deceptively smooth finish

Mountain Goat 'Barrel Breed: Christmas Ale 2015'

(10.0%, VIC, 750ml) Barrel Breed #3, this beer style is a Belgian Quadrupel with "distinct vanilla/whisky sweetness to both the nose and palate". A "big, subtly sweet, spicy brew". Limited release with only 900 bottles produced.

Mountain Goat 'Barrel Breed: Barleywine 2016'

(11.3%, VIC, 750ml). The follow-up to last year's 'Australian Beer of the Year' at the Australian International Beer Awards. Aged in Lark Distillery's old french oak barrels. Smooth, rich, subtly complex and remarkably un-boozy for its size, it possesses a seriously enticing auburn glow and unveils all manner of luscious toffee, caramel, stewed fruit, vanilla and sherry characters

Hargreaves Hill 'The Phoenix'

(9.6%, VIC, 650ml). Imperial Red brewed on the anniversary of the rebirth of the Hargreaves Brewery, following its destruction during the tragic 2009 'Black Saturday' bushfires. Only 500 wax-sealed, individually numbered bottles are produced annually.
